Dear Parent,

Warm greetings from the Principal's desk. First of all, I would like to thank you all for the overwhelming response from your end to our school and your cooperation in the past years. We request the same support and co-operation from you, as we take the step forward for the third academic year of Springdays. Parents are requested to note the following points.

Parents are to ensure that their wards come to school in neat & pressed uniform. This is to instill confidence and discipline in them. Those parents who have not opted for the school lunch, kindly include a vegetable and a fruit as a part of the lunch menu. Lunch should be brought in a separate bag. Two napkins/towel, a spoon and enough water should be brought in the lunch bag. The water bottles should be periodically washed. School also provides good treated water for drinking purpose.

The school handbook has been given to the students. Parents **MUST** read all the rules, regulations, calendar pages and guidelines given in the handbook carefully. They should see to that their wards also follow it. They also have to follow the schedule given in the handbook for the Saturday classes and other working days. No reminders will be sent regarding this. Do insist your ward to carry the handbook to school every day, also on exam days & Saturdays. The students of Std. I & above should sign in the declaration.

Please fill in the details asked for in the ID certificate in the handbook. The respective class teachers will tear off a copy for office use. If you do not know the blood group of your child, administer the blood test, find out the blood group and then fill in the details. The photo to be stuck in the ID certificate will be taken by the school. Parents need not send any photo.

In the box mentioned 'Previous school's name' mention the name of the school your child studied previously, even if it was one or two years before.

Please note that there may be changes in the rules and instructions given in the handbook year to year and so the parents are to go through the handbook in the beginning of every academic year and also in the beginning of every term to remember the points given.

Children should copy the timetable in pencil in the handbook at the back, so that they can re-write it, if there are any changes in the timetable in future.

ID card issued to the children should be worn regularly to the school.

To reduce the weight of the school bag we have provided 3 notebooks for each subject with less number of pages in each, so that each term one can be used and the bag weight will be less. So send only one notebook for each term.

Attendance for Sportsday is very important even if the child is not participating in any of the events. Refer handbook pg:20 rule no.31.

The following are the extracurricular activities provided in the school. For the Junior school i.e. upto 5th std this will be held in the morning from 8.30 a.m. to 9.30 a.m. Junior children have to come to school by the 1st trip (senior trip) bus in the morning to attend these classes. For the Seniors (Std. VI – IX) it will be held between 3.35p.m. and 4.30p.m. The buses will start at 4.35p.m. (exactly half-an hour later than the usual trip) from the school to drop these children.

Your child can join in more than one activity if the allotted days for these activities do not clash.

Std. IX Students can take part in these activities but they will have to miss these classes when they have evening classes (academic) which will be there on seven days every month from 3.35 to 4.30p.m.

The fee should be paid in a single installment by June 30th. The classes will start from next Monday.

Std. IV & V – Please note that Std. IV & V have classes on few Saturdays (mentioned in the handbook). On these Saturdays they will have English SEA. If they are absent on these Saturdays they will be marked absent for these SEAs. On these Saturdays they have to come by the Senior trip bus which will be 45 minutes earlier than the Junior trip timing. They will leave school at 12.35p.m.

Please file all the circulars and keep for future reference.

I once again thank you for the co-operation extended in our joint endeavour in bringing a holistic development in our children.

As we begin the new school year, we at Springdays School feel delighted to share with you the details of some of our programs and our curriculum in Kindergarten.

D for Dance

Springdays Kindergarten curriculum is introducing well-integrated dance and movement program. Every lesson plan has an age-appropriate movement/dance session to make sure that children are up to par with physical health. This not only enables kinesthetic learners but also improves motor development, co-ordination, balance, physical fitness, flexibility and body awareness in children. Most importantly, it fights child obesity that is becoming an epidemic world-wide. This program is highly blended with the curriculum topics in such a way that it reinforces the child's learning. It also acts as a boost to the child's creative expressions and self-esteem. Will be conducted by a Dance and Movement expert from the field.

Leadership Curriculum (LDC)


At Springdays School, we believe that we are not just responsible for the cognitive development of the child. As a school, we strive to bring up every child with a healthy self-esteem, self-awareness, good values and with leadership skills. We have a one-of-a kind curriculum specially designed for this purpose which we impart to our children from PreKG up to 9th standard. Our responsibility, however, cannot be fulfilled without the help of the child's parents. We request your ardent support and involvement to make this program a success.

Communication & Etiquette Through Art & Craft (CETAC)

This year we are also introducing a new curriculum for inculcating etiquette and communication in children. This will be done alongside normal school hours, lunch\snack break and specifically when the child is doing CETAC period. During CETAC periods, children will be split into smaller groups and two CETAC teacher along with the class teacher will help individual children on Etiquette and Communication skills. Art & Craft is like pediatric Speech Therapy for kindergartners. We aim to make the best use of it for imparting Etiquette and Communication skills for our children.

I can cook too!

A lot of kindergarteners are fussy eaters. Through our curriculum, we encourage and use peer influence to get children to eat healthy (if they are already not). This year, we are also introducing a new program 'I can cook too!', where these little kindergartens will become little cooks. They will cook simple, healthy, no-fire recipes and eat them too! This is in an effort to make them appreciate food, the different ingredients and the effort involved in making it.



Little Reader's Kit

Little Readers Kit is a unique reading program for the children of Springdays. Research says that reading develops a part of their brain that no other activity can. It also helps in cognitive development, communication skills and intellectual development. In this age of reducing attention span, children spending time with books helps increase their attention span. Every one\two weeks, each child will be given a new bag of two\four different type of books. Each book is for the parent to sit with the child and read out loud. Parent reading out to the child also strengthens the bond between them. Once children can start reading on their own, reading books to match their level will be given in the kit.

Lego Program for UKG

For two classes in a week, children will be engaged in Lego building to represent their abstract design thoughts in physical forms. The activities in the Lego are also based on the topics taught in the week's curriculum.

A warm welcome to Springdays! School is the second home for a child. Springdays understands this and provides the right climate for your ward to groom and grow.

Let us work together in this joint endeavour to give a bright future for the child and the right chance to explore and experience.

Kindly read through this circular carefully as it contains important instructions for your child who has just stepped into the kindergarten section.

Handbook:-

1. Please fill in the identity certificates in the handbook and send it back within 3 days. You need not stick the photograph of your child. If you do not know the blood group of your child, administer the blood test, find out the blood group and then fill in the details. Handbooks will be issued shortly.
2. Handbooks should be brought to school everyday and parents should check the handbook regularly for communication from the teachers.
3. Circular when sent will be enclosed in the handbook.

Uniform:-

1. It should be spotlessly clean and well pressed.
2. An handkerchief should be sent to school everyday.
3. Children should avoid wearing flowers, anklets and other jewellery. The school will not be responsible for the loss of any jewellery.
4. Please send an extra dress and under-wear in a labelled cover, everyday.
5. Children can wear any comfortable sandals and not slippers.

Snack bag and school bag:-

1. Kindly send a napkin, snack box and water bottle in the snack bag.
2. Avoid sending fancy water bottles.
3. Send only light breakfast, fruits, boiled vegetables or salads for short break. Avoid heavy snacks and fried items like lays, cheetos etc.
4. Please label the school bag, snack bag, snack box and water bottle boldly, with a permanent marker pen.

Leave of Absence:

1. The teacher must be informed through the absence record page in the handbook.
2. Sick children should not be sent to school.
3. If your child has any health problem or allergies, please notify the class teacher.

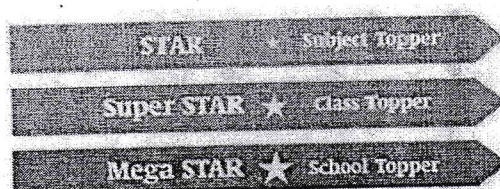

Dear Parents,

The Third Sports Day of Springdays School is being held on Saturday, August 10th at 8.45 a.m. on the school premises.

You are requested to go through the following details carefully and take note of the same.

Bus – Pick up timings on Sports Day:

The Senior buses (Std. VI to X) and the Junior buses (LKG to Std. V) will leave the starting points **exactly 40 minutes earlier** than on a normal working day in the morning to bring the children to school. So, children are to wait 45 minutes earlier (on the safer side) than the usual time in the bus stops for the buses to pick them up.

Bus – Drop timings after the Programme:

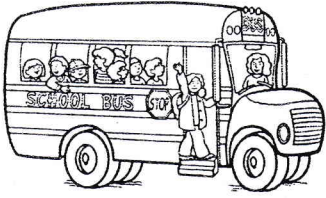
